The Huka Lodge is Hosting an Exclusive Fly Fishing Tournament

Fancy yourself as a fisherman? Then cast a line into the pristine waters of New Zealand's Lake Taupo for the inaugural Huka Lodge Fly Fishing Tournament, to be held from 29 to 31 August. Headquartered in the luxurious Huka Lodge, the exclusive three-day tournament – limited to just 50 participants – is in partnership with experience providers Chris Jolly Outdoors, whose knowledgeable local guides will help bring you an unmatched angling experience.
